### What is IAD?

Incontinence-associated dermatitis describes the skin damage associated with exposure to urine or stool. It causes considerable discomfort and can be difficult, time consuming and expensive to treat.2

Patients are at the center of this condition. IAD can cause discomfort, pain, burning or itching in the affected areas.

### Other issues IAD can cause include:

- Undue burden of care
- Loss of independence
- Disruption in activities
- Sleep disturbance
- Reduced quality of life



## Assessing the Skin

All patients with urinary and/or fecal incontinence should have their skin assessed regularly to check for signs of IAD. Best Practice Principles recommend adoption of a categorization tool to consistently document skin injury.




<sup>\*</sup> Or paler, darker, purple, dark red or yellow in patients with darker skin tones. \*\* If the patients is not incontinent, the condition is not IAD.

### **Pressure Ulcers**

Incontinence is a well-recognized risk factor for the development of pressure ulcers<sup>3,4</sup> which can cause patients suffering and increase the costs of health care.

Prevention of avoidable pressure ulcers and IAD is a clear indicator of the quality of patient care.
